09:00 – 10:00: Indoor and outdoor learning (free flow across both rooms)

10:00 – 10.20: Child initiated snack time

10:20 – 10:30: Carpet time (Maths focus)

10:30 – 11:15: Indoor / outdoor learning (free flow across both rooms)

11:15 – 11:30: Carpet time (Story / Squiggle while you wiggle)

11:30: Home time (AM only children) / Wash hands for lunchtime

11:30 – 12:15: Lunchtime and indoor activities

12:15: Afternoon children arrive / Home time for remaining morning children

12:30 – 1:45: Indoor / outdoor learning (free flow across both rooms)

1:45 – 2:00: Child initiated snack

2:00 – 2:15: Carpet time (Phonics focus)

2:15 – 2:50: Indoor / outdoor learning (free flow across both rooms)

2:50 – 3:00: Get ready for home time

3:00 – 3:10: Storytime

3:15 – 3:30: Children go home

3:30 – 6:00: After school provision

NB: Nappy changes occur throughout the day to meet the individual needs of the child.
